LANGUAGE ARTS

Read often. Your goal should be 15-20 minutes of reading each day. For book suggestions, check out the 2020-2021 Texas Bluebonnet Book Nominees.

Keep a journal. Students are encouraged to start a journal or write fiction stories. Being able to express themselves through writing will encourage the boys to write for a variety of audiences and purposes. Your goal should be 30 minutes of writing each week.

MATH

MASTER your multiplication facts. Basic facts include facts up to 12. This can be done using flashcards, online games, bingo, or any other method. If you have mastered all of the multiplication facts, start on division! Knowing these facts will make 4th grade math faster, easier, and more fun!
