**Math for Rising 7<sup>th</sup> Graders - CO-ED:** This is a 3-session camp over a period of 3 weeks available for incoming 7<sup>th</sup> graders. Each session covers different material. A camper may choose to take all camps or only those that fit their schedule. Each camp is separate and does not carry a prerequisite of a prior week’s camp. Topics covered: fractions and mixed numbers, how to change customary units, percentage, rate and scale drawing, geometry, metric system, GCF & LCM, measures of central tendency, simple interest, sequences, square roots, Pythagorean theorem, functions, volume and surface areas, simplifying polynomials and more!

COST: \$250/each week; Maximum Students Allowed: 12

**Math for Rising 8<sup>th</sup> Graders (Intro. to Algebra CO-ED):** This is a 3-session camp over a period of 3 weeks available for incoming 7<sup>th</sup> graders. Each session covers different material. A camper may choose to take all camps or only those that fit their schedule. Each camp is separate and does not carry a prerequisite of a prior week's camp. Topics covered: Simplifying expressions, solving equations, rates, ratios & proportions, inequalities, sequences, linear functions, factoring methods, probability, completing the square, inverse variation, quadratic functions and more!

COST: \$250/each week; Maximum Students Allowed: 12

**Math for Rising 6<sup>th</sup> Graders CO-ED:** This is a week-long session just in time to get ready for school. Get that math brain working again after the long summer break. Topics covered: multiplication facts, fractions, decimals, mixed numbers, word problems, square roots, applying math to real life situations, using excel spreadsheets in math and more! Snacks/Treats provided and maybe even a break or two in the ga-ga pit (temperature permitting).

### **Spanish for Spanish Speakers & Adv. Spanish for NON-Spanish Speakers CO-ED:**

Spanish for Spanish Speakers is a full language arts program which enables students of Spanish language origin, and others whose proficiency in Spanish allows them to benefit from the program, to become functionally literate in Spanish by reinforcing and acquiring skills in listening, speaking, viewing, reading, and writing. PROGRAM 100% IN SPANISH but for Adv. Spanish for NON-Spanish Speakers. NOTE: Students can attend 1, 2, 3 or all 4 weeks. Studies will be different each week and tailored to current learning/ability levels. Classes are tentative based on enrollment.

COST: \$250/week; Maximum Students Allowed per class: 6

Their programs utilize an "EDUTAINMENT" (education + entertainment) approach, transforming the learning process into a game while introducing children to theoretical and practical knowledge in the fields of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM). LEGO parts will be used in the workshops and each kid will have his/her own tool box. Kids don't need to bring anything into workshops and we will provide all materials.

Two sessions will be run in this Summer. One session is in the week of June 12 while the other is July 10. These two sessions are independent of each, so kids can join one of two sessions or both.
